- **COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This year the students will review the basic Spanish skills: colors, numbers, days of the week and months of the year, telling time, adjectives, and verbs ending in -ar, -er, and -ir. The students will also master essential Spanish vocabulary and concepts which will help them form simple Spanish sentences. Students are expected to participate in class activities. Students are strongly encouraged to share what they have learned with family and friends so that they can build their confidence when speaking Spanish.
- **COURSE OBJECTIVES:** At the end of this school year, students should be able to enjoy reading, writing, and speaking the basic skills they mastered.
- **MATERIALS AND TEXTBOOKS:** Students should have a composition book, flashcards, scissors, colored pencils, pen, pencils, and highlighters. They will be provided with a Spanish/English dictionary and other materials used from various textbook resources.
- **GRADING:** Students will be graded on class work, homework, quizzes, tests, and most importantly, participation and *attitude*.
